HEAVY DUTY TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL BUSINESSES AND WOOD SMOKE

TYPES OF VIOLATIONS

- Administrative- typically associated with record keeping or reporting requirements.
- Operational- Emission source exceeded regulatory standard or failed source test
- Permit- Emission source operating without authority or permit to operate

- Field inspections of pollution sources
- Portable Emissions Acquisition System (PEAQS)- the "Dirty Truck Detector"
- On-site and submitted report audits

ENFORCEMENT STRATEGIES IN THE WEST OAKLAND COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN (WOCAP)

- Updated complaint program
- Increase frequency of compliance inspections at stationary sources
- · Develop education and outreach material on open burning
- Provide inspection summary/complaint information
- · Enhance enforcement referral process
- Identify unpermitted sources
- Investigate and minimize impacts of backyard burning
